Parish Council News

Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 4th April 2016

Council Members

Parish Council members are Jonathan Wallwin (chairman), David Landon (vice-chairman), Eric Briggs, Chris Holliland, Janet Landon, Beatrice McGlen, Alun McKiernon, John Mosley, Ben Wielgus and Fred Withers. Our District Councillor is Teresa Critchley and our County Councillor is John Ogle.

Vacancy - Clerk to the Council

Members thanked the retiring clerk and acknowledged appreciation of her work over the last 6 years since March 2010. A new clerk to the council is now sought, please refer to the job vacancy advert for details.

Local Enterprise Partnerships and Combined Authorities – Devolution

Under this scheme more control is handed down to local government, via an elected mayor, but an extra layer of administration is added.

Bassetlaw DC has signed an agreement to become part of the Sheffield City Region (which includes Chesterfield, Doncaster, Barnsley and Rotherham). A consultation will follow and this will be an opportunity to voice an opinion, albeit retrospectively. Cllr. J. Ogle reported that under the agreement control of highways, transport, spatial planning and economic development will go to Sheffield City Region, but social services and Sure Start will remain under the control of Notts CC.

A petition is in place to demand a referendum on the subject (including one in the Village Hall). If 4,500 signatures can be obtained this will enable a referendum to take place to choose whether we stay with Nottinghamshire County Council or become part of Sheffield City Region.

Nottinghamshire County Council Recycling Centre Service Changes 2016

Following the need to register cars before they can use Nottinghamshire recycling facilities, fly tipping is to be monitored and everyone is encouraged to report cases immediately to Bassetlaw DC.

Cllrs. J.Mosley and J.Landon left the meeting whilst the vote took place; a majority of members voted in favour of no objections, no comments.

Grant for Planting Scheme at Grove

DCllr. Teresa Critchley has obtained a grant of £200 to fund a planting scheme at Grove war memorial. Six volunteers have come forward to carry out the work involved and Teresa is to be thanked for supplying the necessary funding.

Parish Council Notice of Audit – 10th June 2016

The year-end accounts will be prepared for approval at the next parish council meeting.

The external audit submission date is notified as 10th June, an internal audit will take place prior to this date and the accounts will be available for public inspection for a 30 day period during June/July.

Whilst you are welcome to watch the whole meeting, you are reminded that from 7.40pm when the parish council meeting has started proper, any discussion or interruptions from the public is not allowed.
