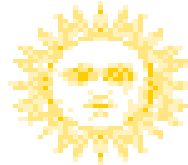

# Parish Council News

## Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 5th June 2017

### Council Members

Parish Council members are Jonathan Wallwin (chairman), David Landon (vice-chairman), Eric Briggs, Janet Landon, Beatrice McGlen, John Mosley, Ben Wielgus, Fred Withers, Sue Browne and one vacancy. Our District Councillor is Teresa Critchley and our County Councillor is John Ogle.

### Councillor Vacancy

We now have a vacancy on the parish council. If you would like to be considered for the position, please phone Jonathan Wallwin 07841508266 for further details.

### Highways

There were no issues reported this month. Our District Councillor is encouraging the County Council to renew the worn junction white lines at road junctions around Upton. It may help if members of the public also report the issue via the Notts County Council portal <http://www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/transport/roads>

### Neighbourhood Plan

### Defibrillators

Cllr McGlen will organise a second training session on how to use a defibrillator in the autumn. We encourage as many people as possible to attend.

### Speed Signage

Cllr Wielgus and Dist Cllr Critchley are investigating prices and options for portable electronic speed signs for the parish, they are also looking into the options of fixed signage.

### Headon Car Park

Cllr David Landon asked Dist Cllr Critchley to look into the possibility of the Parish Council adopting the A1 Housing Car-Park on Church Street.

### Village Lengthsman

We are investigating the pros and cons of employing a lengthsman who would be able to undertake various tasks around the 4 villages, from leaf clearance to litter picking, sign cleaning to verge strimming, there are lots of jobs the role could entail. Sources of possible funding are to be sought.

### Attero Ltd Recycling Centre, Headon Camp Ind Estate

We have received complaints from members of the public regards the site. There are concerns regarding lorries approaching the site through Headon village. The site operators advised they would not take these routes. Other issues highlighted are sawdust billowing around the area and smoke drifting across to domestic properties. We are taking steps to address these concerns with Attero.

### Police

PC Bailey advised no crime was reported this month. PC Bailey asks that if you see any crime in action please dial 999 or 101 (if none urgent) to report it.

### Public Forum Session

The 10 minute Public Forum session is at 7.30pm prior to the parish council meeting giving residents the chance to speak to members.
