Highlights from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 19 November 2018 at Headon Village Hall

Members Present: Eric Briggs (Stokeham), Vaughan Le Floc (Headon), Julia Harvey (Headon), Fred Withers (Stokeham), Janet Askew (Upton), Lynn Whelan (Clerk)

Future meetings

The next meeting is to be held on **Monday 17 December** at Headon Village Hall. Prior to this meeting at 7pm the Parish Council is inviting all villagers for a sherry and mince pie in the village hall. A 10 minute public forum will start at 7.30pm followed by the meeting.

Public Forum - Three members of the public were welcomed to the meeting. Interest was expressed by one member of the public with regard to footpaths.

Councillor Vacancies - Mr S Whelan proposed himself as a Councillor and this proposal was accepted. Sean has played a part in the Neighbourhood Plan and has made other contributions to the villages.

Opportunity for District Councillor to speak

Formation of Unitary Authority – Cllr Critchley will be attending a meeting with regard to this and will report back to the Council. Areas such as Transport, planning, etc. will possibly be affected.

Planning – There was previously reported to be a lack of a 5-year housing supply but recent studies and changes in methodology have revealed that Bassetlaw now have a 7-year land supply for new houses.

Headon Camp – made a summary of historic planning applications. Still intending having a meeting with Miles Joyce re. agricultural repair/limiting scale as it is a rural location.

Police – Police are currently dealing with the current drug problem in Mansfield and so may have limited resource for rural policing.

Advertising on lamp posts, etc. Advertising of village events in North Leverton are posted on signage in the village. However, the council have been taking down signs and banners, saying that it is illegal.

Police Report -Mention was made with regard to a letter from Cllr Ogle to the Police Commissioner. The increasing crime is meaning that farmers are increasing their own security measures.

Footpaths/Highways - Concern was expressed with regard to the uncut hedgerows on the main road between Grove and Headon.

Footpaths need clearing and a footpath from Upton to Headon has a rotten bridge which has to be crossed. There was also one footpath with appears on the local maps but isn't waymarked on the ground. The Lengthsman will be assigned to clear some paths.

Planning Applications and any other planning issues

18/01321/FUL Erect Agricultural Storage Building – land south of Drayton Road, Upton

Concern was expressed with regard to this application. The Council determined to object to the application.

18/01446/FUL Erect 3 dwellings (1x 4-bed detached and 1 pair of 2-bed semi-detached) – land at Hilltop Farm, Upton

It was proposed that the Council object on the basis that it does not abide to the Neighbourhood Plan but more evidence will be gathered to present a balanced view.
